**The following stipulations are in effect for FCAA member schools:**

1. A member school must believe in salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Good works, such as baptism and church membership, are not part of the salvation experience.
2. A member school must agree to abide by all dress code guidelines and all policies of the FCAA (See dress code and by-laws at [www.fcaasports.com](http://www.fcaasports.com)) Failure to conform with FCAA rules and regulations will result in the termination of school membership in the league.
3. It will be the responsibility of the school principal to make sure that the coaches and fans conduct themselves in such a way as to honor the Lord.
4. The school acknowledges that the FCAA is not responsible for student injury. This is the sole responsibility of the member school. Each school must provide student accident insurance for its participants.
5. Any team that qualifies for the state play-offs is expected to attend the play-offs. A school that withdraws from the play-offs will be charged \$100. (NOTE: NEW RULE)
6. Home-schoolers participating in member school's sports program must be registered with the member school and pay the applicable fee set by the school. A member school may not use students that are enrolled in any other middle school, junior high, or high school. No participating student athlete may be over 19 years 9 months in age.
